RULES FOR THE ELAND TROPHY 2024

- 1. All matches to be played over 21 ends on a "two rinks at home and two rinks away" format and the result will be decided on the <u>total aggregate</u> shots only across both the home and away rinks after the 21 ends.
- 2. The first named club home rinks shall draw, prior to the start of game, a rink to play an extra end in the event of a tie in the overall aggregate. The result of this extra end is only to be used in the event of a tie in the overall aggregate.
- 3. In the event of two rinks played and the other two rinks being cancelled due to inclement weather the two postponed rinks is to be played within seven days of the original match day to avoid delaying the next round of the competition.
- 4. The first named bowls club in the draw will have the jack in both the home and away rinks of the Eland Trophy.
- 5. No trial ends except in the final.
- 6. Games to be completed on the fixed days with Final Date and Venue being confirmed later.
- 7. Dress code is as league matches up to and including the final.
